

proceedings, in full and final satisfaction of all Claims, as defined in the Claims Process Order, of Compton against Darian, subject to paragraph 4 below.

2. The late claim filed by Mustang in the Claims Process is hereby accepted and the Monitor is directed to forthwith pay to Mustang the sum of \$62,046.87 out of the funds held in the Disputed Claims Reserve in full and final satisfaction of all Claims of Mustang against Darian.


3. The late claim filed by CFR in the Claims Process is hereby accepted and the Monitor is directed to forthwith pay to CFR the sum of \$38,765.97 out of the funds held in the Disputed Claims Reserve in full and final satisfaction of all Claims of CFR against Darian.

4. The additional Claim of Compton against Darian in the sum of \$113,935.82 is permitted to be filed in the Claims Process (the "Additional Claim"), but is deemed not to be accepted until such time as Darian agrees, or this Court orders, that the Additional Claim is accepted. The Monitor is directed to pay the sum of \$114,935.82 out of the Disputed Claims Reserve to Borden Ladner Gervais LLP ("BLG"), representing the amount of the Additional Claim, plus \$1000 for additional interest, to be held in trust by BLG until Compton and Darian agree in writing as to the quantum of the Additional Claim, or until further Order of this Court. Any amounts held in trust by BLG which are not paid to Compton shall be paid to Crescent Point Energy Corp. ("CP"), for the sole use and enjoyment of CP, and free and clear of any Claims against Darian.


5. The Monitor is directed to release all remaining funds in the Disputed Claims Reserve, namely \$225,223.21, to CP for the sole use and enjoyment of CP, and free and clear of any Claims against Darian.

6. Service of this Order shall be made on all persons who appeared on the Applications, either by counsel or in person, but is otherwise dispensed with.





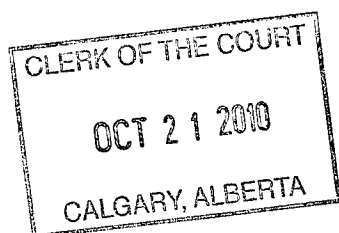
